



4 DAYS 3 NIGHT SIEM REAP PACKAGE TOUR (2 days Angkor Wat Pass)

DAY 1 SIEM REAP ARRIVAL (DINNER)

Upon arrival, pick up then transfer to check in hotel if room available in the morning. Visit **Floating Villages** of **Chong Khneas**, located 10 kilometers south of Siem Reap. Take a ride in a traditional wooden boat on the Tonle Sap, the "Great Lake" of Cambodia and the largest in Asia. Here you'll see plenty of examples of the Khmer way of life on the Tonle Sap. Check in hotel. Dinner at local restaurant.

DAY 2 SIEM REAP (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

Breakfast at hotel. Visit ancient city of **Angkor Thom** (12th century): the **South Gate** with its huge statues depicting the churning of the ocean of milk, the **Bayon temple**, unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara, the **Royal Enclosure**, the **Phimeanakas**, the **Elephant Terrace**, the **Terrace of the Leper King**, and **Ta Prohm**, one of the most beautiful temples in the area, as it has been relatively untouched since it was discovered and retains much of its mystery. Lunch at local restaurant. After that proceed to visit the most famous of all the temples on the plain of Angkor: **Angkor Wat**. Its distinctive five towers are emblazoned on the Cambodia flag and the 12th century masterpiece is considered by art historians to be the prime example of classical Khmer art and architecture. Angkor Wat's five towers symbolize Meru's five peaks - the enclosing wall represents the mountains at the edge of the world and the surrounding moat, the ocean beyond, **Sunset from Phnom Bakheng hill**, one of the two hills dominating the plain of Angkor, from where you will have a spectacular view of the Western Baray and the surrounding plain. Dinner with apsara dance show and over night in Siem Reap.

DAY 3 SIEM REAP (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

Breakfast at hotel. Visit **Banteay Srei** is considered by many to be the jewel in the crown of Angkorian art. A Hindu temple dedicated to Shiva, it is cut from stone of a pinkish hue and includes some of the finest stone carving seen anywhere on the planet. It is one of the smallest sites at Angkor, but what it lacks in size it makes up for in stature. It is wonderfully well preserved and many of its carvings are three-dimensional. Banteay Srei means 'Citadel of the Women' and it is said that it must have been built by a woman, as the elaborate carvings are too fine for the hand of a man. Then visit **Banteay Samre temple**. Lunch at local restaurant. Late afternoon, visit **Chantiers - Ecoles - les Artisans d' Angkor"**. Here you could witness the creation of unique art pieces using the most authentic methods. These pieces are created by young Cambodians from rural area, **Silk Farm**. Dinner at local restaurant and over night in Siem Reap

Breakfast at hotel. Free at leisure till time transfer to airport for departure.
