



6 天 台北/香格里拉休閒農場/礁溪溫泉 (GV2-逢星期日) TOUR CODE: CS6

第一天 接機/酒店(不包餐)

集合於國際機場，準備搭乘豪華客機前往美麗寶島台灣，抵達後將由專業導遊接機前往住宿之飯店。

第二天 台北/野柳/九份/宜蘭/香格里拉休閒農場-晚上放天燈、打陀螺、搓湯圓等鄉土活動(早晚餐)

*午餐自理於九份品嚐小吃

*野柳: 野柳的地形可分成主要地形景觀及小地形景觀，著名的景點有：女王頭、仙女鞋等。

*九份: 它是昔日的金礦產區，也是今日電影悲情城市的外景地。那裡可以品嚐草仔粿、蕃薯芋頭丸、潮州魚丸等各式小吃。

*香格里拉休閒農場: 體驗農場生活，親近大自然，晚上安排放天燈、搓湯圓及打陀螺等鄉土活動。

第三天 早上果園生態之旅/中山休閒農業區/鵝山茶園-DIY 茶燻蛋/蘭陽傳統藝術中心/四結福德宮/ 礁溪溫泉-裸湯(早/午/晚餐)

*宜蘭中山休閒農業區: 宜蘭縣素以擁有優美綠林美景見稱，其中位於縣內冬山河上游的中山休閒農業區，更滿布觀光農場、果園及茶園，田園氣息極濃。

*鵝山茶園: 鵝山茶園提供的 DIY 茶燻蛋體驗活動。

*國立傳統藝術中心: 乃一以民間藝術為主體的多能文化園區，除提供民間藝術一諸如傳統工藝、美術、音樂、戲劇、舞蹈等的推廣、傳承之展演空間，同時亦是富有文化教育意義的多功能休閒遊憩區

*四結福德宮: 台灣最大的土地公廟、也是意難忘偶像劇的拍攝地。

*礁溪溫泉: 馳名最早，是臺灣少見的平地溫泉。在清代即為馳名的「湯圍溫泉」，早就被列入「蘭陽八景」之一。

第四天 礁溪/雪山隧道/台北/台灣民主紀念館/ 忠烈祠/毛公主之家/淡水老街/漁人碼頭/士林夜市(早/午餐) *晚餐自理於士林夜市品嚐小吃

*台灣民主紀念館: 整個建築充分顯示中國特色之美，氣勢雄偉，公園內名花異卉，小橋流水，景觀壯麗。

*忠烈祠: 祠內供奉著歷年忠勇犧牲的烈士牌位及建國史蹟圖片，並能觀賞衛兵換班交接儀式。

*淡水老街: 可以品嚐到美味的阿婆鐵蛋、阿給、淡水魚丸等都是不可錯過的道地美食，還可以欣賞百年歷史的老鎮以及著名的淡水日落。

*漁人碼頭: 遠眺觀音山，欣賞台灣八景之一的「淡江夕照」，流星花園拍攝地點。

*士林夜市: 士林夜市是台北夜市中最具規模的一個，商品價廉物美、貨品齊全。人潮絡繹不絕。

第五天 台北/袖珍博物館/故宮博物院/辟邪展示館/深坑豆腐街/101 購物中心-觀景台自費/西門町 (早/午餐) *晚餐自理

*袖珍博物館: 收藏二百多件袖珍藝術品的袖珍世界博物館，規模為亞洲第一、世界第二的袖珍藝術品展覽館，主要呈現整座建築主體內外佈置的袖珍娃娃屋、各種房間精緻寫照的夢幻屋盒，其中有全世界最小的電視、「昔日風采」(造價七百萬元)、比例一比一百二十的「樹上礦坑」等。

***故宮博物院:** 是一座中國宮殿式的建築。其中收藏近七十萬件國寶包括寶藏、名人書畫、陶瓷器、銅器、翡翠、雕刻、錦屏、刺繡和歷史文物。

***深坑豆腐街:** 街道兩旁全是販賣遠近馳名之深坑豆腐,其特色是豆腐之製作過程:不滲石膏而是採用鹽滷方式做成,再加上特殊烹調手法,使豆腐吃起來口感滑嫩、唇齒留香!

***101 購物中心:** 在世界上最高的大樓享受寬廣、舒適的購物樂趣

***西門町:** 各式衣飾及手飾品均為時下最流行的款式,交通方面亦非常便捷, 有 MRT 直達西門站。

Day 02 Taipei/ Yehliu/ Chiufen/ Yian/ Shangrila Leisure Farm-Play some traditional games at night (Breakfast / Dinner) *Lunch own expenses in Chiufen

***Yehliu:** The natural rock formations of Yehliu. (wild willows) are an amazing array of artistic shapes created by erosion and other natural forces.

***Chiufen:** To see the old fashioned way of life that still exists. With the aura of an old mining that still apparent, Chiufen radiates a variety of emotions.

***Shangrila Leisure Farm:** You will have the change to play some traditional games and visiting this farm is to see exactly how the fruit grows in the trees.

Day 03 Fruit Range Living Experience in the morning/ Yilan Juang Shan Leisure Agricultural Region/ Eo Shan Tea Garden-DIY Tea Smoked Egg/ National Center of Traditional Arts/ Sih Jie Fu De Temple/ Jiau Shi Hot Spring (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

***Yilan Juang Shan Leisure Agricultural Region:** Enjoy many beautiful tourism farm, fruit range & tea garden around there.

***Eo Shan Tea Garden:** Experience DIY tea leaf smoke egg.

***National Centre of Traditional Arts:** The Folk Arts Park is a multi-functional park that helps Promote traditional folk craftsmanship, arts, music, drama, and dance and is also a multi-functional, resting place for cultural and educational purposes.

***Jiau Shi Hot Spring:** It's the famous Hot Spring, and the infrequent flat land hot spring of Taiwan.

Day 04 Jiau Shi/ Hsueshan Tunnel/ Taipei/ National Taiwan Democracy Memorial Hall/ Martyr's Shrine/ Mao Princess's House/ Tamsui Old Street/ Fisherman Wharf/ Shihlin Night Market (Breakfast / Lunch) *Dinner own expenses in Shihlin Night Market

***National Taiwan Democracy Memorial Hall:** Is the most impressive monument to the great Chinese Hero. The hall's enormous marble edifice towers over landscaped garden, graceful pavilions and placid ponds. The bronze statue of late President Chiang Kai-Shek looks out over the city from the main building.

***Martyr's Shrine:** To view an elaborate ceremony of changing guards hourly.

***Tamsui Old Street:** It's a place where the Tamsui River meets the Taiwan Strait . More than just a great place for fresh seafood, nature provides the town with beautiful views. Like Keelung, Tamsui has a colorful history.

***Fisherman Wharf:** You can see one of the famous view "sunset in Tamsui" there. You can take the boat go through the "Blue Way" to Tamsui Old Street. It's Meteor Garden Photography place

***Shihlin Night Market:** Great place of local handicrafts, clothes, toys, tasty local snacks and souvenirs

Day 05 Taipei/ Miniature Museum/ National Palace Museum/ Handicraft Center/ Sankeng Tofu Street/101 Shopping Mall-Observatory own expense/ Hsimen Tien (Breakfast / Lunch)

***Miniatures Museum of Taiwan:** Within around 200 miniature arts in the museum. You will see various of dollhouse and romboxes in the museum. Also the smallest TV is in the museum as well. Don't miss the amazing trip to the mini world!

***National Palace Museum:** The world's largest assemblage of priceless Chinese art treasures, one which spans Chinese's nearly 5,000 year history.

***Sankeng Tofu Street:** You could not only taste the delicious Tofu but also experience the process of Tofu making.

***101 Shopping Mall:** Enjoy your shopping in the tallest building in the world.

***Hsimen Tin:** The most popular shopping area where people will choose. Just enjoy your shopping.
